

MOUNTAIN BIKING INFORMATION

The closest trail to the cabin is:

Ridgeway Mountain Bike Trail in Ellijay

6 miles of loop trails. The Ridgeway mountain bike trail system is located in Ridgeway Park at Carters Lake off Hwy 282/76. Riders pass through mountain vegetation along high ridges that overlook deep clear water, then descend to cross small creeks. Trail features include a mixture of single track and narrow logging roads along with challenging climbs, stream crossings and technical downhills.

Other Ellijay Georgia Area Trails

Call Cartecay River Bike Shop at 706-635-2453. Located at 131 N. Main Street, you'll find maps and helpful staff recommendations.

River Loop which is about 3.5 miles and the **Red & White Loop** 2.5 miles, are two good trails which are close to town. They are about 5 miles east of Ellijay on GA 52.

Fort Mountain State Park - This park is in this area also and has many things to offer. It has great camping, activities and two bicycle trails. They are the **Gold Mine Loop** and

Cool Springs Loop. Information about biking trails and what the park has to offer can be obtained from:

ASKA Trails Area

East of Ellijay and south of Blue Ridge, this area contains a 17-mile hiking and mountain biking trail system located on Chattahoochee National Forest land near Deep Gap and Stanley Gap trails that ascend to near 3,200 feet, providing vistas of mountain ridges, and descend to the shores of beautiful Lake Blue Ridge. To get there go North on GA 76 from Ellijay & East Ellijay. Some of the trails are **Stanley Gap Trail, Flat Creek Loop, Green Mountain Trail (upper), Green Mt. Trail (lower), and Long Branch Loop**. Information is available from the Toccoa Ranger District and the National Forest Information Office in Dahlonega.
